Animal Services is asking for the public's help in attempting to locate a biting dog in Esparto.

On Sunday, May 28, 2017 at 5:30 pm a resident of the 13000 block of County Road 85 was bitten by a stray dog after it entered her yard.

The victim describes the dog as a mostly brown and white pit bull. She indicated she had not previously seen the dog and did not know who owns it. The dog was not wearing a collar.

The victim told the responding Animal Services Officer the dog came onto her property and attacked her dog. She suffered bites on both arms attempting to break up the fight. The dog fled on County Road 85 in an unknown direction.
